Background & Governance



The Social Club was formed in Oct 1976 following a period of trial bars, though the bar staff have only been paid since the late 80's. The constitution was revised in 2000 and introduced the "Bar Management Committee" as the committee – since this better reflects the duties of the committee. Since 2000 there have been several changes, mainly due to the change in the licensing law in 2003 which introduced some significant changes; as well as some minor alterations to our present Constitution (Sept 10).

Objectives

"The Objectives of the Club shall be to further the interests and objects of the Hanham Community Centre (hereafter called "HCC") as laid out in the Governing Document of the Hanham Community Centre through the provision of refreshments, including intoxicating liquor, in support of HCC activities."

Based on these objectives, the role of the Social Club committee is purely to manage the provision of bar services to meet the needs of the centre – hence "Bar Management Committee"; its role is no longer to provide entertainment or Social Activity in the Lounge Bar – this now falls to members, under the governance of the Trustees.

Annual Report & Accounts



Overall the Bar Management Committee (BMC) has ensured the bars have met the need of the centre by providing bars for functions, events and funerals – as well as the lounge bar. It has managed the provision of bar staff.

The Social Club shows an overall accounting deficit of £167; but has paid £33876 to the centre in "Rent". Generally the reversal of the recent trend remains with an income of £122K, though this is a slight fall of £4.4K (of which £1.3K is due to a drop from the Sports Ground bar). Functions remain the key ingredient, with the lounge bar slightly down again – a trend that is unlikely to reverse.

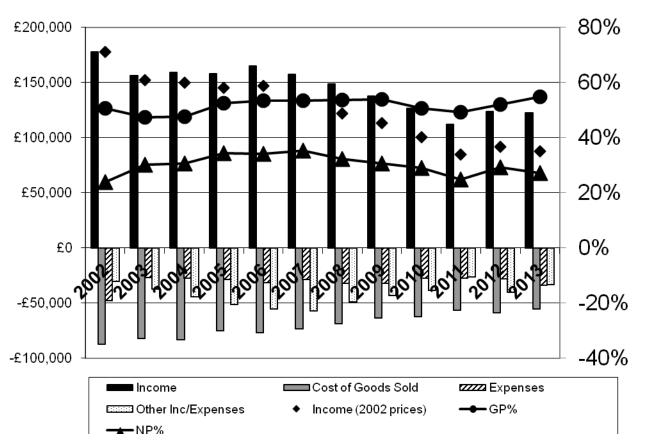
Overall Gross Profit is slightly up (2%) at 55%, although the Sports Ground Bar gross profit is only 40%, compared to the centre bars operating at 57%.

BMC Trading Fund

As you may well know, the centre has recently changed the legal format of the charity from an unincorporated charity to a charitable incorporated organisation (CIO), and is currently finalising the transfer and registration of the CIOs land.

As part of this work, our solicitor has recommend the Trustee revise the format of the legal mechanism for providing alcohol from the current "social club" construct to a formal trading fund owned by the CIO. This has been agreed by the Trustees and a CIO AGM, but now needs formal ratification from the Social Club AGM, which will include the formal dissolution of the current club (in accordance with Clause M).

This resolution is to approval:

"The dissolution of the Social Club (at an appropriate time) by the Trustees to enable a new "Trading Fund" to undertake the supply of alcohol and refreshments on HCC premises to meet the needs of the users".
