

Operation of Hanham CC Cricket Club for 2020 season

If you or anyone in your household are showing symptoms of Covid-19 **DO NOT** visit the ground until you have completed the required period of isolation.

Please be reminded to wash your hands on a regular basis for at least 20 seconds with soap and water and use the disposable towels available in the toilets. Also remember to catch coughs and sneezes in tissues – follow Catch it, Bin it, Kill it and avoid touching face, eyes, nose or mouth with unclean hands.

Please remember the importance of social distancing at all times.

1. Arrival at the ground

- If arriving by car please park a safe distance from other vehicles.
- Everyone (players/spectators/parents) please report to the front of the pavilion where you are required to enter your name in our daily log (this is a requirement for test and trace purposes).
- The Away captain will provide a list of his players prior to the start of the game. Other visitors will be entered into the daily log by the Home Captain.
- Spectators/parents are allowed on any area of the field, as always, but please keep a 2 metre distance from other spectators (and will need to provide contact details).
- Players must put their playing equipment in the designated area marked for home team and away team on the outfield outside the pavilion and gather outside the pavilion maintaining social distancing from other players/spectators/parents.

2. Pavilion

- All areas of the pavilion are out of bounds except for the toilets.
- Hand sanitiser is available on a table at the front door and must be used on entry and exit from the pavilion.
- Users are encouraged to wash their hands in the toilets, adhering to the 20sec guidance.
- Only **one** person at a time is allowed in the pavilion.
- Clear signage is in place within the pavilion. Please respect these signs and adhere to them.

3. In the event of rain

- In the event of rain, players will return to their cars and **NOT** enter the Pavilion.
