

**HANHAM COMMUNITY CENTRE SNOOKER SECTION COVID 19
RISK ASSESSMENT AHEAD OF REOPENING THE SNOOKER ROOM.
SEPTEMBER 2020**

Objectives - To reduce the spread of Covid 19

Who might be impacted – Staff, Members, snooker visitors plus other centre users who may come into contact with snooker players.

Controls required –

Hand washing: Ensure the cloakrooms are maintained with good hygiene and adequate disinfectant soap and water in place. Antibac hand sanitizers to be made available at the entrance to the Centre and in the snooker room.

Cleaning: Room needs to be cleaned on the days in use with disinfectant including door handles, lights and equipment. Players to use their own cues and we can remove any club ones. Snooker balls, table edges, scoreboards and triangles need cleaning after each session.

Limit entry with 2 tables side by side, if we limit room to a max capacity of 4 / 2 per table, we can maintain social distancing. A recording system is needed with customer contact details and playing times and kept for 21 days. A book to be placed in the room. Suggest for now we restrict to members only whose records will be held, and no spectators. Coaching currently restricted to 1 to 1 only s.t. social distancing and no sharing of equipment. Competitive snooker limited to singles.

Signage Required –

Player guidance per the re-opening steps template to be placed on the room door and on the walls at each end of the two tables.

Modus Operandi

Email all 2019 members to outline the terms of re-opening, revised membership costs and clarify hours available. Players to ring before coming to the Centre to check table availability.

With only 6 months of the year left, snooker section subs will be reduced to 50% - £7.50 Adults and £3 for juniors. We understand the Community Centre are maintaining their £12 membership fee.

Players to be asked to clean any shared rests, balls and table corners pre and post their games. (Centre will supply cleaning fluid / cloths.)

Players to bring an adequate supply of 20p's.

Room Layout

Reorganise furniture to leave just 4 x tables and 4 x chairs to use.

Each player to have an allocated rest / table / chair.

Remove surplus equipment from the room and store safely ftb.

Whilst playing, ideally door to be kept open to aid ventilation.
